

TREASURE is a EU H2020 funded project Aim:

Improve the knowledge, skills and competences necessary to develop existing and create new sustainable pork chains based on European local pig genetic resources (20 local breeds), which correspond to the highest consumer demands for quality and healthiness of pork products, and to the societal demands regarding animal welfare, environment and rural development.

How does it work?

The project activities are structured in five interrelated Work Packages (WPs):

- 1. WP1 Phenotypic and genetic characterization of regional autochthonous pig populations in Europe
- 2. WP2 Management and performance of local pig breeds in their production systems
- 3. WP3 Traditional and new high quality pork products with regional identity
- 4. WP4 Consumer preferences and market research for sustainable pork chains
- 5. WP5 Measures to maximise impact
